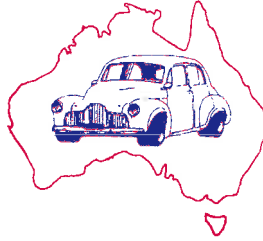

i.e. Delegate meeting are usually held at State Titles annually could be 15 months apart. Consistent with existing 9.01

i.e. Consistent with 9.06 (Nationals)

Example : Victoria has 8 Member Club 2/3 would Require 6 Member Clubs being 3/4 .

2. Racers must not have any steering mechanism of any description ( however trimming of direction is allowed)
3. Racers if modified must retain 80% of original shape
4. Racers must not weigh more than 4.5kg (10lb)
5. Racers must not be wider than 19cm (7 1/2 ) including wheels
6. Racers must have more than 5cm (2") ground clearance at the front. (This is for starting purposes)
7. Judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
