BY-LAWS

The following by-laws were adopted at the Annual General Meeting held on Sunday August 12th 2007 at Across the Waves Sports Club. All members are to adhere to the by laws at all times.

1. If you have one or more vehicles on concessional registration, then at least one of these vehicles is to be driven to at least three Club meetings or outings per year.
2. If you own one or more vehicles on concessional registration and any one of the vehicles is being restored or repaired and you are unable to meet the requirements of By-Law 1 then permission to seek an exemption from By-Law 1 must be given to the Executive Committee and shall be tabled and voted on at the next general meeting.
3. Members are to conduct themselves in a responsible manner and abide by all road rules at all club functions and outings eg. no burnouts.
4. That any person wearing club shirts shall be seen as a representative of the Club and act in a responsible manner.
5. That all complaints must be submitted in writing to the Management committee within seven (7) days of said complaint arising and will be dealt with at the next Club meeting.
6. That personal information on any member will not be divulged without their authority.
7. Membership fees will be revised at every Annual General Meeting and these fees will include a Club newsletter whenever one is printed.
8. That membership shall be annual from 1st July to 30th June.
9. That membership application received between 1st July to 31st December be accompanied by the full prescribed fee.
10. That membership application received between 1st January and 30th April be accompanied by half the prescribed fee.
11. That membership received between 1st May and 30th June be accompanied by the full prescribed fee and be applied to include the ensuing year.
12. That the application for membership or the application for renewal of membership must be on the prescribed form and shall include the prescribed fee.
13. That the rights and privileges of financial members shall cease to apply if the member has fees in arrears for a period of two (2) months.
14. Membership shall lapse if a member has fees in arrears for two (2) months
15. New Members must be financial for at least six months and attend at least three club functions, meetings or outings before an application for concessional registration can be made to the club
15. By -law 15 ammended at The Annual General Meeting 2011 to read
New members must be financial for at least five (5) meetings or outings before an application for concessional registration can be made.
16. Single membership to pay for any extra people attending club functions.
17. The Bundaberg Early Holden Club shall commence its meetings at 9.00AM.
18. to remain a member of The Bundaberg Early Holden Club Inc then you must attend three club meeting or functions/ outings a year
18. By-Law 18 ammended at AGM august 2010 to read.
To remain a member of The Bundaberg Early Holden Club Inc, you must attend at least five (5) meetings/ outings per year, Moved Garth Stubbins Seconded Bob Butterworth Carried

19. Members are to wear club shirts at all Club functions and meetings.
20. The aim of the Bundaberg Early Holden Club Inc. is to promote an interest in Early Holdens.
21. That no one is to use the name Bundaberg Early Holden Club Inc on or for any advertising unless authorised by The full Executive.
22. That no one, other than the Club Social Director or someone authorised by the full Executive can organise Club runs or outings.
23. That any authorisation given by the Executive must be in writing or on Club Letter Head.
- 24 That the Management Committee review these by -laws and report to the Annual General Meeting
25. New Members should be present at the meeting after their membership form has been received to be voted in. If they are unable to attend that meeting, their membership application will be held over until they are able to attend.
26. New members have to be financial members and abide by Club By-Laws for 12 months before being eligible to stand for Executive Committee Positions.
